- 11-734 A resolution by Supervisors Biddle and Haas, providing for an advisory referendum on the April 3, 2012 election ballot to inquire of Milwaukee County residents whether all Wisconsin workers should have the right to seek safe working conditions and fair pay through collective bargaining.
