10 AN ORDINANCE
11

12 To amend Sections 201.24 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County as
13 appropriate to clarify the optional forms of benefit available at retirement to members of
14 the Employees' Retirement System.
15

16 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as
17 follows:
18

19 **Section 1.** Section 201.24(2.18)(2) is amended to read as follows:
20

21 (2) Normal retirement age shall be age fifty-seven (57) for a member who is a ~~deputy~~
22 sheriff sworn law enforcement officer at the time his employment terminates.
23

24 **Section 2.** Section 201.24(4.1)(1)(a) is amended to read as follows:
25

26 **4.1. – Normal Retirement.**

28 (1) (a) A member shall be eligible for a normal pension if his employment is
29 terminated on or after he has attained age fifty-five (55) and has completed
30 thirty (30) years of service, or if his employment is terminated on or after he
31 has attained normal retirement age as defined in section 2.18. ~~Deputy~~
32 sheriffs Sworn law enforcement officers shall be eligible to retire at age fifty-
33 seven (57) regardless of their number of years of service or at age fifty-five
34 (55) with at least fifteen (15) years of creditable pension service.
35

36 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (a), a member of the
37 International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers whose initial
38 membership date is before January 1, 2012 shall not be eligible for a normal
39 pension until the member has attained normal retirement age as defined in
40 section 2.18 and has completed five (5) years of service.
41

42 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (a), a member of the
43 Federation of Nurses and Health Professionals whose initial membership date
44 is before January 1, 2012 shall not be eligible for a normal pension until the
45 member has attained normal retirement age as defined in section 2.18 and has
46 completed five (5) years of service.

48 **Section 3.** Section 201.24(4.1)(2) is amended as follows:

50 (2) Rule of 75.

51 (a) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is not covered
52 by the terms of a collective bargaining agreement, and whose initial
53 membership in the retirement system under section 201.24 began prior to
54 January 1, 2006, and who retires on and after September 1, 1993, shall be
55 eligible for a normal pension when the age of the member when added to his
56 years of service equals seventy-five (75), but this provision shall not apply to
57 any member eligible under section 4.5 nor to any nonrepresented deputy
58 sheriff who was hired as a deputy sheriff after December 31, 1993 and whose
59 appointment to a nonrepresented position was first effective after June 30,
60 2009, nor to a member who was formerly a represented correction officer who
61 was hired as a correction officer after December 31, 1993 and who was
62 appointed to a nonrepresented position effective after May 1, 2011.
63

64 (b) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is covered by
65 the terms of a collective bargaining agreement with the American Federation of
66 State, County and Municipal Employees District Council 48, or with the
67 Technicians, Engineers and Architects of Milwaukee County, or with the
68 International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, and whose
69 initial membership date is prior to January 1, 1994, shall be eligible for a
70 normal pension when the age of the member when added to his years of
71 service equals seventy-five (75), but this provision shall not apply to any
72 member eligible under section 4.5.
73

74 (c) A member who, on December 31, 2012, is employed and is covered by the
75 terms of a collective bargaining agreement with the Federation of Nurses and
76 Health Professionals, shall be eligible for a normal pension when the age of
77 the member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but
78 this provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.
79

80 (d) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is covered by
81 the terms of a collective bargaining agreement with the Association of
82 Milwaukee County Attorneys, and whose initial membership date is prior to
83 January 1, 2006, shall be eligible for a normal pension when the age of the
84 member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but this
85 provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.
86

87 (e) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is covered by
88 the terms of a collective bargaining agreement with the Milwaukee Building
89 and Construction Trades Council, and whose initial membership date is prior to
90 February 21, 2006, shall be eligible for a normal pension when the age of the
91 member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but this
92 provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.

(f) A member who was employed and covered by the terms of a collective bargaining agreement with the Milwaukee Deputy Sheriffs Association on September 29, 2011, and whose initial membership date is prior to January 1, 1994, and who is not represented by the Milwaukee Deputy Sheriffs Association at the time of the employee's retirement, shall be eligible for a normal pension when the age of the member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but this provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.

(g) A member who was employed and covered by the terms of a collective bargaining agreement with the Milwaukee County Firefighters Association (IAFF Local 172) on September 29, 2011, and whose initial membership date is prior to December 2, 1996, and who is not represented by the Milwaukee County Firefighters Association (IAFF Local 172) at the time of the employee's retirement, shall be eligible for a normal pension when the age of the member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but this provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.

Section 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
