24 25	The election commission shall provide the Ethics Board with a copy of all filings under this paragraph by county elected officials who have filed to be a candidate for office.
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27 28 29 30	(3) <i>File within thirty (30) days of employment or taking office:</i> Upon entering county employment, elected office, or appointment as a public official, persons required to file statements of economic interests shall do so within thirty (30) days after commencement of employment or of taking oath of office.
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32	(4) Annual statement of economic interest filing requirement:
33 34 35 36	(a) [Requirements.] Each person required to file a statement of economic interests shall file updated statements with the ethics board within thirty (30) days after the closing of each calendar year. <u>A filing made by a county elected official</u> under section 9.03(2) shall fulfill that year's annual filing requirement.

37	(b) Quarterly financial disclosure required for pension board: Each member of the
38	county pension board and each employee of the pension board who is a county
39	official or employee, shall complete and file with the ethics board a quarterly
40	financial disclosure statement no later than the last day of the month following
41	the end of each calendar quarter or any portion thereof in which he or she was
42	a member or employee of the county pension board. Such financial disclosure
43	statements shall be in the form prescribed by the ethics board and shall identify
44	the date and nature of any purchase, sale, put, call, option, lease, or creation,

47	(c) No compensation until filing: A person required to file a statement of economic
48	interests under this section shall not receive his/her salary or other
49	compensation until he/she files such statement of economic interests.
50	(d) Disclosure by spouse: County elected officials, appointed officials, candidates,
51	and employees required to file statements of economic interests, as required by
52	section 9.03, shall include and file statements of a spouse's employment and
53	financial assets and liabilities.
