## A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Land and Water Resource Management Plan (LWRM) is to conserve soil productivity, protect the quality of related natural resources, enhance water quality, and focus on soil erosion; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 92, Wisconsin State Statutes, requires counties to develop a Land and Water Resource Management Plan with plan updates conducted every ten years, or to be granted a five-year extension if originally approved for five years, to be eligible to receive State conservation funding; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) previously approved Milwaukee County's LWRM Plans in 2001, 2006, and the current plan in 2011; and

WHEREAS, the current plan is eligible for a five-year extension from 2017 through 2021; and

WHEREAS, the County Board must approve the extension before it goes to the State Land and Water Conservation Board for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of July 19, 2016, recommended adoption of the Director's request (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the five-year extension of Milwaukee County's Land and Water Resource Management Plan for a time period effective from 2017 through 2021.

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
