The board may, in its discretion, deny nembership to any class of employes whose compensation is only partially paid by the county r who are serving on a temporary or other than per annum basis.
co re ex	<u>b)</u> The pension board shall be given no less than thirty (30) days to comment in writing to the ounty executive and the county board upon the fiscal impact of proposed benefit changes eferred from the county board. The pension board may request of the county board an attension of time to comment. In making its referral, the county board shall make full disclosure to the pension board of all actuarial information utilized in the proposed benefit changes.
	c) In exercising its powers under section 8.17(a) or under section 8.6, on any question otentially affecting the rights of two or more current or future members, the board shall not take ction before receiving and reviewing a fiscal analysis.
