1 Supervisor Gerry Broderick, Chairperson, 2 From the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, reporting on: 3 4 File No. 15-690 5 6 ) A resolution by Supervisor Weishan, Jr., requesting that the Director, 7 Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) collaborate with the Wisconsin 8 Department of Natural Resources to develop a coyote management plan and 9 authorizing an appropriation transfer of up to \$25,000 from the Appropriation for 10 Contingences to DPRC, by recommending adoption of the following: 11 12 A RESOLUTION 13 14 WHEREAS, recently there have been multiple complaints related to coyotes in 15 the City of Wauwatosa as a result of three separate fatal attacks on local residents' 16 dogs; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County residents expressed concerns to the Wisconsin 19 Department of Natural Resources (DNR) requesting a course of action for addressing 20 the growing coyote problem; and 21 22 WHEREAS, on October 6, 2015, a public meeting was held with Wauwatosa 23 officials and the DNR to discuss how to combat the coyote issue and keep residents 24 and their pets safe; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the DNR stated that population control, such as culling, is not an 27 effective method for coyotes, and instead causes a surge in their breeding patterns; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the City of Mequon's Common Council adopted a Coyote Nuisance 30 Management and Response Plan Policy on August 11, 2015, to provide a strategic 31 action plan for handling incidents between humans and coyotes, which includes hazing 32 efforts to instill a fear of humans, as well as a removal system conducted by contracted 33 professionals, if necessary; and 34 35 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has a duty to its residents to address the valid 36 safety concerns of their families, pets, and property; and 37 38 WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of 39 October 27, 2015, recommended adoption of this resolution (vote 5-1); now, therefore, 40 41 BE IT RESOLVED, the Director, Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture 42 (DPRC) is requested to collaborate with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to develop a strategic plan of action to address coyote nuisance within 43 44 Milwaukee County (the County) and to implement measures that ensure the safety of all 45 residents and their respective property, which may include a removal procedure for 46 patterned coyote nuisance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Office of Performance, Strategy, and Budget, Department of Administrative Services, is authorized to process an appropriation transfer to appropriate up to \$25,000 from the Appropriation for Contingencies account to the DPRC to be used towards the development of a coyote management plan for the County; and

 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, any coyote management plan developed by the DPRC is to be implemented as soon as practicable, beginning with primary emphasis on the Wauwatosa area; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if it is determined that the appropriated \$25,000 is insufficient to cover the costs of the coyote plan development and its implementation, the DPRC may submit a request for an additional appropriation transfer to address the remaining costs for this program.
