1 Supervisor Supreme Moore Omokunde, Chairperson, 2 From the Committee on Health and Human Needs, reporting on: 3 4 File No. 16-505 5 6) From the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting (ITEM 7 authorization to begin negotiations with Carmelite Home for Boys for youth who are 8 eligible for a Department of Juvenile Corrections placement, by recommending adoption 9 of the following: 10 11 **A RESOLUTION** 12 13 WHEREAS, in response to the crisis at Lincoln Hills School for Boys operated by 14 the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections, the Delinquency and Court Services 15 Division (DCSD) has been working to identify a Type II Residential Treatment Center 16 (RTC) to serve as a step down from corrections while allowing the opportunity for local, 17 community-based treatment placements for the highest risk youth; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the goal of this programming would be to keep as many youth as 20 possible close to their homes and community while being able to provide the 21 appropriate supervision and treatment to these youth while maintaining community 22 safety; and 23 24 WHEREAS, DCSD has been in the planning phase of locating a facility and 25 identifying the appropriate programming for a Type II RTC within Milwaukee County (the 26 County) for the following targeted population: 27 28 Youth at risk of being placed in the State Department of Juvenile 29 Corrections (DJC) 30 Youth transitioning out of the DJC 31 Youth transitioning out of the Milwaukee County Accountability Program 32 (MCAP) detention phase who cannot go home right away due to the need 33 for additional support, supervision, or family issues 34 35 ; and 36 37 WHEREAS, the original intent was to pursue a Request for Proposals (RFP) to 38 identify a provider for the programming component of the RTC, but the challenges 39 posed by this plan include the scarcity of appropriate facilities in the community due to 40 location, square footage, condition, design, zoning, and investment of time to 41 rehabilitate a building to meet the needs of the program; and 42 43 WHEREAS, the layout and condition of the Carmelite Home for Boys (Carmelite)

are conducive to the development of a staff secure residential program; and

WHEREAS, Carmelite has expressed an interest in collaborating with DCSD to provide the facility and the programming for this RTC and has the space available to do so with little modifications needed; and

WHEREAS, treatment and educational services would be provided on site by Carmelite and Wauwatosa Public Schools, with necessary collaboration from the Wauwatosa Police Department to ensure a swift response to any serious incidents that may occur at the facility; and

WHEREAS, if DCSD does not pursue this option, the RFP process could cause a significant delay in getting the RTC operational and ready to accept youth by early 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Health and Human Needs, at its meeting of September 14, 2016, recommended adoption of the Director's request (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) hereby authorize the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, or his designee, to pursue negotiations for a Level II Residential Treatment Center with the Carmelite Home for Boys as the operator and licensee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, once negotiated, the contract and total amount will be submitted to the County Board for approval.
