- A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to allocate approximately \$1,736,181 in anticipated 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding and \$1,257,077 in HOME funding.
- B. The HOME funding is included in the 2017 DHHS Budget for the Housing Division. The majority of the \$1.7 million in CDBG funding is included in the division's 2017 Budget. Approximately \$300,000 of the \$1.7 million is being provided by reallocated CDBG funding from prior years. This \$300,000 is part of a larger spending plan totaling \$774,000 in reallocated CDBG funding. This spending plan is detailed in another report pending in the October cycle. A fund transfer will be submitted to adjust the budget by \$774,000 to recognize the additional expense and revenue as a result of this reallocation.
- C. While recognizing that future Federal allocations of grant awards are always uncertain, it is anticipated that the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) will provide the grant revenue in 2017. In no case will program expenditures exceed available revenue. As a result, there is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request.
