Subject: Update on Local Zoning Designations on Existing County Park Land

- INFORMATIONAL

ISSUE

An update to File No. 16-315 regarding the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture's (DPRC) review of local zoning designations on existing County parkland.

BACKGROUND

On February 4, 2016, the Milwaukee County Board passed File No. 16-121 requesting the rezoning of 43 parcels identified in File 15-785. The County Executive's Office submitted written requests to each appropriate municipality on January 25, 2016 for the 43 parcels identified in File No. 16-121. These parcels were related to DPRC's review of parks owned by Milwaukee County.

In addition to the January 25, 2016 request, on February 29, 2016 the County Executive's Office submitted written requests to each appropriate municipality for the rezoning of land which is not used for general park purposes, but is used for parkways, trails and environmental management.

The attached map shows which parcels were already zoned parks prior to the 2016 County request, and which parcels were requested to be rezoned as parks by the County Executive during the first quarter of 2016.

The following table compiles the progress that has been achieved on the parkland rezonings to date:

³ Parcel is vacant land, primarily wetlands, currently zoned M-1, Manufacturing. Exhibit attached.

Where applicable, rezonings that were approved in municipalities that have overlapping zoning districts for shoreland-wetland, floodplain, or flood fringe areas did not change those overlying designations.
