  - A. Approval of this resolution will authorize that the trail segment from Estabrook north towards the Ozaukee Urban Trail be named the "Chris Kegel Connection", to honor the life and contributions to the bicycle and recreation community by Mr. Chris Kegel.
  - B. The Parks Department may work with the Milwaukee County Trails Council to determine the appropriate signage for the designated area. The signage cost of \$500.00 is able to be absorbed within the department's budget, unless another contribution or private funding source is identified. If any private financial contributions are later received for signage, those funds would be deposited into the DPRC's operating account. Also, it is expected that maintenance of the area will continue to be included in the established park maintenance staff duties.
  - C. The funds for the signage were not appropriated in the 2016 Adopted Budget, and would therefore result in a \$500.00 expenditure for the DPRC. This action will have no impact on the subsequent year as this would be a one-time expenditure for signage.
