

From the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting authorization to allocate approximately \$1,736,181 in anticipated 2017 Community Development Block Grant funding, and \$1,257,077 in HOME funding, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, as part of the annual plan process, on September 12, 2016, a public hearing was held during the meeting of the Committee on Economic and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, for 2017, a review process was put in place by staff to objectively rank Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects based on a scoring system to make final recommendations, and a panel was arranged to score each project based on this system; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 Milwaukee County (the County) CDBG allocation totals approximately \$1,736,181, which includes \$300,000 of reallocated funding; and

WHEREAS, 20 percent of the total funds can be used for administration; and

WHEREAS, 15 percent of the total funds can be set aside for public service projects; and

WHEREAS, the allocation continues to be split between at-large competitive projects and municipal projects; and

WHEREAS, although the municipal projects were not scored and ranked for the purpose of this report, they are included to show the complete allocation; and

WHEREAS, projects must serve low-to-moderate income individuals within the County CDBG jurisdiction, otherwise the County cannot fund these projects per the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations; and

WHEREAS, the HOME program was born out of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 and was a spin-off of the CDBG program; and

WHEREAS, the County, as a designated Urban County, is part of a HOME Consortium with West Allis and Wauwatosa; and

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44 WHEREAS, approval by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County
45 Board) of the recommendations for the 2017 HOME funding, anticipated to be
46 \$1,257,077, in HUD revenue and program income, is required to complete the 2017
47 Annual Action Plan, which is submitted to HUD; and
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49 WHEREAS, the Wauwatosa and West Allis Consortium member shares are set
50 aside based on their "hold harmless" amounts; and
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52 WHEREAS, all recommended CDBG and HOME projects fit the priorities and
53 objectives of the five-year Milwaukee County Consolidated Plan; and
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55 WHEREAS, all County CDBG and HOME funds must be spent outside the City
56 of Milwaukee; and
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58 WHEREAS, pending County Board approval, the 2017 Annual Plan will be
59 published for comment for 30-days, as required, then any public comments will be
60 incorporated into the final 2017 Annual Plan and it will then be submitted to HUD for
61 approval; and
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63 WHEREAS, in no case will program expenditures exceed available revenue; and
64 projects will be adjusted on a percentage basis if the final award from HUD differs from
65 the County's funding amounts; and
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67 WHEREAS, the Committee on Economic and Community Development, at its
68 meeting of October 24, 2016, recommended adoption of the Director's request
69 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,
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71 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby
72 authorizes the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, or his designee, to
73 allocate the total anticipated 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and
74 HOME funds to the following projects:
