2016 Successes

- Published 4 Procedures: Administrative Manual of Operating Procedures (Effective Communication; Service Animals; Wheelchairs, Mobility Aids, & Other Power-Driven Mobility Devices; & ADA Grievance Procedure)
- Successfully filled 53 of 53 sign language interpreter requests and 14 of 14 assistive listening device requests (through September)
- Developed 6 ADA Accessibility Improvement Projects (thru Sept)
- Operating the Wil-O-Way's at a 46.3% Self-Sufficiency Rate (thru Sept)
- Hosted 546 events at the two Wil-O-Way's in 273 days (thru Sept)
- Working w/ Parks Department & the Ability Center on RampUp MKE (beach wheelchairs, ice sleds at Wilson/Red Arrow ice rinks, & hand-cycles at Veteran's Park)
- Coordinated 510 sailing opportunities for persons w/ disabilities with the Milwaukee Community Sailing Center
- Fostered New Relationships (Bryant & Stratton Sensory Garden at Grant; Wounded Warrior Project Peer Support Group at Underwood)
- Distributed 57,000+ Newsletters (Handy-NEWS & NOTES, Rec on Deck) (thru Sept)
