










Parks, Recreation & Culture Department 2015-2016 Completed Capital Improvement Projects



Mitchell Park Domes - Plan/Netting



Budget \$1.472 million. Mesh installation completed in all 3 domes by October 29, 2016 for just over \$1 million and long-term planning is underway.



Sherman Park HVAC





- Budget \$2.2 million
- Completed November 2016



 Replace heating, air conditioning, and ventilation (HVAC) system for the Sherman Park Boys and Girls Club building



Hoyt Park Suspension Bridge Restoration

- Cost \$500,000
- Completed May 6, 2016
- Historic restoration including replacement of cracked and missing facing stones, resealing



stone joints and buttresses, repointing stone joints, adding flashing to protect against water penetration, replacing steel floor beams and cross bracing, and replacing the support for the center stringer with a support that will shed water and reduce corrosion





Menomonee River Pkwy Road Reconstruction



New roadway, curb and gutter, green infrastructure including rain gardens and bio-infiltration cells, new electrical services and lighting, new off road segment of the Oak Leaf Trail, and traffic calming in the form of raised, colored crosswalks

- Cost for all three phases \$10 million
- Completed July 2016

- Slope stabilization to address erosion damage along the Oak Leaf Trail near Hubbard Park in Shorewood caused by 2010 flooding events.





Honey Creek Parkway and Jacobus Park Lighting Replacement



- Cost \$257,000
- Completed July 2016
- Removal of existing dysfunctional lighting system and installation of new lights and lighting control system in Jacobus Park and along the Honey Creek Parkway between N 68th St and N 60th St





Jackson Park Electric Service Upgrades



- Cost \$335,000
- Completed: October 2016



• New WE Energies electrical service to replace the outdated City of Milwaukee electrical service to the service yard, boathouse, bath house and pool. Project included removing existing electrical system components and installing new distribution and service panels, controls, junction boxes, conduit and wiring, meter pedestals and sockets, etc.



Domes Electrical System Replacement







- Cost \$390,000
- Completed September 2016

 New WE Energies electrical service including removing existing electrical system components and installing new distribution and service panels, controls, junction boxes, conduit and wiring, meter pedestals and sockets, etc.

- Cost \$357,000

- Renovated greens and bunkers along back nine golf holes (holes 10-18)
- Greens and bunkers for front nine were renovated in 2010





Hales Corners Park Bath House Roof Replacement

- Cost \$304,000
- Completed June 2016
- Replaced cedar shake roof with metal roof, eliminated hidden gutter system, replace eaves and soffits and soffit lighting






Hales Corners Park Swimming Pool Renovations
