The fund shall receive all revenues from the operation of the railroad and zoomobiles, and, in the discretion of the zoo director, any other revenues from other zoo attractions and activities or unrestricted donations. The fund may be used for expenditures for the following purposes and in the following order of priority:
30			(1) Defraying the cost of railroad operations;
31 32 33			(2) Replacement, additions, extensions and/or improvement of the railroad, including its road bed and rolling stock;
34 35 36 37			(3) Purchase of additional train(s), when in the determination of the zoo director patronage and public demand warrant it;

The fund shall receive revenues from the sale of animals and, in the discretion of the zoological director or designee, the fund may also receive revenues from zoo attractions and activities, other than from the operation of the railroad and zoomobiles, and from unrestricted donations. The

47		fund may be used for expenditures for acquiring animals and
48		related expenses, and for the benefit and/or improvement of the
49		zoo, including staff education and development expenses, and for
50		expenses related to zoo conservation programs.

52		(c) The Conservation and Research Program fund established
53		by the county board (December 15, 2016). At the discretion of the
54		zoological director or designee, the fund may receive revenues
55		from zoo attractions, activities and donations except for those
56		identified in (a) and (b), for expenditure towards conservation,
57		research, green practices and the overall benefit and improvement
58		of the Zoo.

60	(2)	The railroad trust fund, and the specimen fund and conservation and
61		research program fund shall be carried over from one (1) year to the next
62		subject to legal restrictions.

64	(3)	The funds shall be invested by the county treasurer.

66	(4)	Interest from investment income on the funds is to be credited to the funds
67		and not the county general fund.
