Through the 2017 County Budget Adoption, JusticePoint was approved for a contract with the Wisconsin Department of Justice for the TAD (Treatment Alternatives and Diversion) Program. At the time of the budget preparation, it was anticipated that PreTrial Services would enter into a contract with JusticePoint in the amount of \$371,200. However, it was later determined that the DOJ was increasing the grant budget to \$380,981. This additional amount is 100% reimbursement through the grant. A fund transfer will be completed in order to make allowances for the additional 2017 revenues and expenditures.
