19 20 21 22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, the above workgroup should consist of representatives from the Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS), the Department of Transportation, Department of Health and Human Services, the Department on Aging, the Department of Administrative Services, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors, GO Pass users, and representatives of advocacy groups for persons with disabilities and seniors; and
26 27 28	WHEREAS, the administration of the eligibility screening process will be done by the Milwaukee County Aging Resource Center and the Disability Resource Center; and
29 30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, shifting administration of the GO Pass Program from MCTS to the Aging and Disability Resource Centers will allow those programs to better provide access to publicly funded programs that support elders and individuals with disabilities; and
34 35 36 37 38	WHEREAS, the GO Pass workgroup met twice in February 2017 to discuss such matters as determining future eligibility for current GO Pass holders, communication with current GO Pass holders, communication to the community at large, and a timeline for implementation of changes; and
39 40	WHEREAS, the GO Pass workgroup plan including communication strategies and timeline are outlined in the report accompanying this resolution; and
