

From the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court Related Operations, requesting authorization to accept a 2017 Treatment Alternatives and Diversion grant in the amount of \$380,981 from the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the 2017 Budget (File No. 16-567) was adopted by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors on November 7, 2016, and was approved by the County Executive, which included funding for the Treatment Alternatives and Diversion (TAD) grant (Grant Number 01-12017) in the amount of \$371,200 from the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County Pretrial Services was notified of its TAD grant enhancement award in the amount of \$380,981 on September 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, JusticePoint was awarded the TAD contract through a Request for Proposals (RFP) process (RFP # 98160003); and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Safety, and General Services, at its meeting of March 9, 2017, considered File No. 17-238 for informational purposes only; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of March 16, 2017, recommended adoption of File No. 17-238 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court Related Operations, to accept the Treatment Alternatives and Diversion grant (Grant Number 01-12017) in the amount of \$380,981.
