| 19 20 21 22 23 | WHEREAS, in the most recent annual report on child abuse and neglect from the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families (DCF), Child Protective Services received a total of 76,442 referrals of alleged child maltreatment in 2015; and |
| 23 24 25 26 27 | WHEREAS, of the alleged maltreatment referrals, 4,679 children suffered from substantiated maltreatment at a rate of 3.6 children per 1,000 children in Wisconsin; and |
| 27 28 29 30 31 | WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect can be reduced by making sure each family has the support they need in raising their children in a safe and supportive environment; and |
| 32 33 34 35 | WHEREAS, all communities have the responsibility to offer parents the education, support, and skills they need to provide healthy, safe, and nurturing homes for their children; and |
| 36 37 38 | WHEREAS, in one study of maltreatment prevention programming, the CDC found a benefit/cost ratio of \$47 in benefits to society for every \$1 in program costs; and |
