- A. Approval of this resolution will authorize the Milwaukee Public Museum ("MPM") to construct a stormwater retention and recycling project in the courtyard of the Museum. County Board approval is required per Section 4.1 of the Lease and Management Agreement with MPM to make this improvement to the property. MPM is using approximately \$161,000 in grant funds received from the Metropolitan Milwaukee Sewerage District (MMSD) and Fund for Lake Michigan to create the "MPM Green Demonstration Project."
- B. Approval of this resolution will permit MPM to construct the "MPM Green Demonstration Project" using grant funds. No County funds are used or obligated.
- C. Approval of this resolution will not result in an impact to the County Budget.
- D. No assumptions were used.
