Friends of Pulaski Park are submitting request for matching funds to be able to purchase new windows for the main meeting area of the pavilion located in Pulaski Park in the city of Cudahy.

All old windows in this area will be removed and replaced with new commercial windows by the Feldco Company which is located in the City of Cudahy.

The windows to be installed are vinyl clad, almond color. They are double pane-argon filled glass which is said to be nearly indestructible. They are Energy Savers with an insulation rating of R-15. Each of the lower windows will have a screen which is made of Gortex. This fabric adds to the insulation value as it filters the sun. View through the screen is clear which it adds a tint like look from the outside making it slightly difficult to look inside the building. The upper windows will be picture windows and will not be able to open.

Twenty-six windows will be installed at this time. Fifteen double hung and eleven picture. This is the total number of windows in the main area. They will have the same grate style as the present windows to keep the integrity of the present windows.

The window warranty is not pro-rated. Screens and glass will replaced free if ever necessary.

We have been assured that the same windows type will be available as funds permit us to do the windows in the rest of the building.

The Mission Statement of Friends of Pulaski Park-Cudahy is: "to restore, improve, safeguard and preserve Pulaski Park in Cudahy to make it a desirable, enjoyable, usable and safe place for families and an asset to the community today and for future generations."

With this in mind, we have been fund-raising continuously in the past two and one half years to make this goal a reality. Replacing the windows in the pavilion is one step in the process of making it a facility that could be rented by the public.

It is a building filled with history and character. It was used for parties and eventually became the warming house for skaters who used the ice rink that was created in the winter in the Southeast area of the park. When skating was discontinued, the building was used for storage and became deteriorated. The beautiful fireplace in the building has since been restored and is usable.

There have been requests by the public through the year to rent the pavilion for showers, birthday parties, meetings, graduation parties and wedding anniversaries. With the Parks Department permission, our group has held various fund-raising events in the pavilion to assist the goal of upgrading it and the park itself.

Another benefit of replacing the windows is to add to the curbside appeal of the building. It will bring out the character and beauty of the 1930s era pavilion. It will be another example of the beauty of Milwaukee County Parks. In addition, heating cost would be lower with the added insulation value of the new windows.

#### SPONSOR COMMITMENT

Friends of Pulaski Park-Cudahy has been working with the Milwaukee County Parks Department for the past two and one half years. During that time we have had many fund-raising events and have received donations from various private citizens, local groups and business with the sole purpose of adding to the beauty and usability of Pulaski Park. We have become members of the PARK PEOPLE who have secured fiscal responsibility for the group.

Our fund-raising efforts have brought about visible changes to the park itself and the pavilion for which we are seeking matching funds. We were able to clean the interior of the building and clean and preserve the 90 year old beautiful wood paneling.

We received a donation of oak cabinets for a future small kitchen area just outside the main room.

We have had park clean-ups with our members and have enlisted the assistance of two neighboring grade schools to keep the park neat and rubbish free. With the assistance of Brian Russert and team we have planted 125 native plants in the "natural" uncut area of the park. Donation of \$500 from the Steren Corporation made this possible. We purchased these plants from Boerner to further give back to the park system.

Our commitment to the park is visible and firm.

All work for window installation and necessary repairs to the openings, if necessary, will be contracted to Feldco Windows, a local company. A copy of the proposal is attached. These windows are maintenance free. The warranty is not pro-rated.

We will look forward to being able to wash the windows as necessary as we have had no luck in cleaning the present yellowed plexi- glass storms that cover the old windows.

All work will be approved by the parks building service director.

This project, if completed, will not only decrease cost to the park system but will increase the potential of income from rental fees.

Presently, the pavilion is heated to maintain a temperature that would prevent damage from below freezing temperatures. The insulation factor of the new proposed windows should decrease the loss of heat in the building thus making it easier to heat and maintain the heat in the room. Winter rentals of this building are also a factor to consider.

The potential income from rentals would also be an asset. Though it may take time to re-coup the dollar investment, having a building that is usable and beneficial to the public can only increase its value. If we get matching funds, the cost to the county will be half of the total cost of installation. The windows will also increase the longevity of the structure. It was built originally by the WPA during the Depression. This makes it a part of history. If possible, it is always better to preserve than tear down.

There will be no additional cost involved once the windows have been properly installed. They are maintenance free and the warranty is not pro-rated.

#### 8. PROPOSED BUDGET

We presently have \$5436.50 being held by the Park People in our account with them.

The amount proposed for the window project by Feldco is \$10,873.00. We are asking for funds of \$5436.50 as a match to be able to afford the project to completion.

One-half of the project is due upon signing of the agreement and the other half at completion of the project. We have enough in our account to be able to sign the proposal and anticipate construction and installation of the 21 windows.

We have met with other contractors and have found that Feldco has the best price, guarantee and service. The professional attitude they presented was very assuring. The added bonus is that they are a local company located in the city of Cudahy.
