I write this letter in the hopes that the City and County will consider making the south side of Layton Avenue a no parking zone between 60<sup>th</sup> street and 57<sup>th</sup> street in order to put a right turn lane in to service 57<sup>th</sup> street (entrance to the high school). When cars are allowed to park on the south side of Layton, it constricts the flow of traffic in the morning making it difficult for parents to drop their students off in a timely manner. When cars are allowed to park in this area, it also causes an unusually large number of accidents as cars attempt to park in the morning while a heavy flow of traffic is trying to enter the parking lot. I have personally watched the traffic from the Meijer's parking lot in the morning numerous times to get a first hand understanding of what was happening and witnessed not only congestion, but also accidents.

Our students have ample parking available to them in our parking lot and on Layton Avenue east of 57<sup>th</sup> street. The only event that we need parking outside of our lot is during graduation when our families are able to park at some local businesses. Taking away the parking on the south side of Layton will not be a hardship for any of our students and families.

It is my belief that the addition of a right turn lane will better serve the families of the community that transport students during the school day.
