- A. Approval of this resolution will authorize the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture to accept \$5,000 from the Greenfield Little League as full payment of league fees for 2017 and no fees in 2018. It is assumed that the Greenfield Little League may contract with any contractor of municipality in 2018 for the maintenance and upkeep of the little league fields at Kulwicki Park. The resolution authorizes the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture to develop and execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Greenfield for the maintenance and upkeep of Kulwicki Park upon adoption of this resolution until December 31, 2018. This resolution also maintains that Milwaukee County will continue to be responsible for any long-term capital needs of Kulwicki Park.
- B. This resolution, if adopted, reduces little league revenues in 2017 from approximately \$17,270 to \$5,000. It is anticipated that Milwaukee County will continue to provide the maintenance and upkeep of Kulwicki Park for the remainder of 2017, however if an MOU is executed prior to January 1, 2018, the City of Greenfield will assume the maintenance responsibilities at that time, and could possibly result in additional operational cost savings for the County in 2017.

In 2018, the reduction in revenue is approximately \$17,270 due to the Greenfield Little League paying no fees to Milwaukee County; however, there is a savings to Milwaukee County of \$60,150 because maintenance and upkeep will be provided by a contractor or a municipality. Currently, all leagues are charged based on use of the fields for practices and games at an hourly rate. At the time that this fiscal note was prepared, the invoices for Greenfield Little League's games and practices at Kulwicki Park total \$17,270 for 2017.

- C. The reduction of league fees for 2017 from approximately \$17,270 to \$5,000 will likely increase the County's projected deficit for this year because these revenues were included in the 2017 Adopted Budget. (The Comptroller, in a report dated August 28, 2017, projected the County will end 2017 with a deficit of at least \$1.6 million based on financial activity through June 30, 2017). At the time this fiscal note was prepared, the fiscal impact in the 2018 budget year cannot be determined, as the 2018 Budget has not been adopted. However, in 2018, Greenfield Little League fees are reduced to \$0 with a reduction in maintenance and upkeep of \$60,150, which would result in a net savings of \$42,880 to Milwaukee County.
