

From the Deputy Chief of Staff, Office of the County Executive, requesting authorization to create one full-time equivalent Community Engagement Coordinator position in the Office on African American Affairs (OAAA) and to process an administrative fund transfer in an amount up to \$38,645 from the Appropriation for Contingencies to the OAAA, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Office on African American Affairs (OAAA) provides critical services for the citizens of Milwaukee County; and

WHEREAS, the Community Engagement Coordinator position was created in the 2017 Recommended Budget but was later removed by amendment; and

WHEREAS, the creation of one Community Engagement Coordinator position would allow the OAAA to foster community collaboration through a comprehensive outreach program; and

WHEREAS, the request to approve the classification for the position was reviewed separately by the Committee on Personnel as part of File No. 16-633; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of October 30, 2017, recommended adoption of File No. 17-513 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the creation of one full-time equivalent Community Engagement Coordinator position (Pay Grade 26M) in the Office on African American Affairs (OAAA); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Department of Administrative Services, in conjunction with the Office of the Comptroller, is authorized to process an administrative fund transfer in an amount up to \$38,645 from the Appropriation for Contingencies to the OAAA for the purpose of supporting the position being created.
