This resolution authorizes the Executive Director, Department on Aging, to execute six (6) purchase of service contracts for 2018 that provide a wide range of programs and services to Milwaukee County seniors age 60 or older. The adoption of this resolution will not require the expenditure of any County tax levy not previously authorized in the 2018 Adopted Budget.

This resolution has no fiscal impact on 2018 other than the allocation of staff time required to prepare the accompanying report and resolution.
