SUBJECT: Claim filed by Milwaukee County Transit

I request that this matter be referred to the Committee on Judiciary, Safety and General Services to be placed on the agenda for its next meeting to approve the payment of \$729.87 to Milwaukee County Transit to settle in full their claim against Milwaukee County.

This accident occurred on May 03, 2012 around 3:15 pm on N. 27th St. south of W. Capitol Drive, Milwaukee, WI.

A Milwaukee County Deputy Sheriff legally parked her squad in a stall on N. 27th St. and opened her drivers' door. As she did this, a Milwaukee County Transit bus was passing by and struck the drivers' door which had been opened into traffic.

Milwaukee County Transit submitted an invoice for repair, which includes labor and material used to repair the right front corner of the bus which was the impact point on the bus. The total labor costs are \$446.60 for 6 hours. Paint and supplies are \$200. Loss of use for a day is \$83.27.

The adjustor and the County insurer recommend a total payment of \$729.87 to Milwaukee County Transit to settle this property damage claim. Corporation Counsel has reviewed this matter and supports the recommendations to pay Milwaukee County Transit to settle all claims arising out of the property damage to their vehicle.
