I request that this matter be referred to the Committee on Judiciary, Safety and General Services to be placed on the agenda for its next meeting to approve the payment of \$1,273.16 to Daniel Roddy to settle in full his claim against Milwaukee County.

This accident occurred on June 24, 2012 around 11am in the parking lot located at 4001 S. 20^{th} St., Milwaukee, WI.

Daniel Roddy, who is also a Milwaukee County Parks Employee, claims his personal parked vehicle was struck by a County utility cart with a small dump bed on the back. The operator of the golf cart was backing the cart out of the work garage located at 4001 S. 20th St., Milwaukee, WI. He was unaware that the claimant had parked his vehicle outside of the garage. Mr. Roddy parked his car to the side of the garage. There are no marked parking stalls in this location. However this is a black topped area where employees park on a daily basis.

The claimant vehicle is a 2003 Cadillac CTS. Mr. Roddy submitted an estimate in the amount of \$1138.16. Damages are located on the left rear door and quarter panel on the vehicle. The damages appear to be in line with a larger utility cart with a dump bed backing up and striking the vehicle.

An offer of \$45 per day for three days loss of use was made to the claimant. This would be comparable to three days rental on evenicle similar to a Cadillac.

The adjustor and the County insurer recommend a total payment of \$1,273.16 to Daniel Roddy to settle this property damage claim. Corporation Counsel has reviewed this matter and supports the recommendation to pay Daniel Roddy to settle all claims arising out of the property damage to Mr. Roddy's vehicle.
