From the Director, Department on Aging, requesting authorization to execute Purchase of Service Contracts with: Legal Action of Wisconsin, Inc., in the amount of \$348,562 for benefit specialist/legal services; Interfaith Older Adult Programs, Inc., in the amount of \$495,000 for programs in Clinton and Bernice Rose Park, McGovern Park, Washington Park, Wilson Park, and Lawrence P. Kelly Senior Centers; Goodwill Industries of Southeastern Wisconsin, Inc., in the amount of \$1,082,903 for case management and delivery services for home-delivered meals; Interfaith Older Adult Programs, Inc., in the amount of \$571,158 for family caregiver support and Alzheimer's disease direct services; United Community Center, Inc. (UCC), in the amount of \$373,189 for programs in the UCC Senior Center; and Transit Express, Inc., in the amount of \$1,407,161 for specialized elderly transportation services, for the period effective January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018, by recommending adoption of the following:

## AN AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the 2018 Adopted Budget for the Milwaukee County (the County) Department on Aging (the Department) allocates revenues and expenditures for the purchase of a variety of supportive services and community programs for older persons who reside in the County; and

WHEREAS, in the 2018 Adopted Budget, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) provided \$200,000 in contingency for senior center operations to offset the County Executive's 2018 Recommended Budget, which reduced senior center operations by \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive's 2018 Recommended Budget reduced the contract for senior center operations by \$200,000 to \$1,122,867, which is the amount of the contract for 2018 submitted by the department, but the County Board's additional \$200,000 in contingency funding ensures that all five senior centers will remain open five days a week, and continue to offer a wide variety of recreational and educational activities for older adults; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission on Aging was created by Chapter 53 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances as the designated Area Agency on Aging for the County under the Older Americans Act; and

WHEREAS, consistent with Section 59.52(31)(c) of the Wisconsin State Statutes, the Department must, on behalf of the Commission on Aging, bring contracts of \$300,000 or more to the County Board for authorization; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 10, 2017, the Commission on Aging recommended awarding the following Purchase of Service Contracts for the period effective January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018:
