ADD AND/OR DELETE AS FOLLOWS:

Add the following WHEREAS clauses at or about line 16:

WHEREAS, subsequent to the submission of this file to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors, the Office of the Comptroller analyzed the contracts and determined that eight of the contracts submitted can be entered into by DHHS and the County Executive, without County Board approval; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, several of the contracts are for emergency shelter care, a critical safety net for Milwaukee County residents facing homelessness, which the County Board has fought to adequately fund for several years; and

<u>WHEREAS, in September 2013, the County Board received information from the</u> <u>Shelter Task Force that emergency shelter care would receive a substantial cut in federal</u> <u>funding of \$585,000, in response the County Board, by amendment, provided an</u> <u>additional \$300,000 for emergency shelter funding in the 2014 budget; and</u>

<u>WHEREAS, the County Executive's Recommended Budgets removed the</u> additional \$300,000 in emergency shelter care funding in 2015 and 2016, which led to the County Board restoring the funding by amendment in both the 2015 and 2016 budget; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the County Board lacks statutory authority to modify contracts and may only approve or deny contracts that the Administration submits; and

Amend the following BIR clause at or about line 18:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize and direct the Interim Director of the Department of Health and Human Services, or her designee, to enter into 2018 Housing Division purchase of service contracts, effective January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018, with the agencies and in the amounts listed below <u>as determined by the Department of Health and Human Services</u>:

<u>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Interim Director of the Department of</u> <u>Health and Human Services and the County Executive are requested to explore the</u> <u>potential of surplus funds in the 2017 Budget to amend existing contracts with emergency</u> <u>shelter care providers to provide services from 2017 into 2018; and</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if 2017 funds cannot be carried over, the Interim Director of the Department of Health and Human Services and the County Executive are requested to provide a report and recommendation in the first quarter of 2018 on options to fully fund emergency shelters at their 2017 levels for the balance of 2018 by identifying any available funds within the department; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2018 Adopted Budget included the following language:

Prior to enacting any direct service cuts, departments will work with the Department of Administrative Services – Performance, Strategy, and Budget to identify opportunities to re-organize, streamline, consolidate, eliminate, or otherwise reduce duplication and the cost of administrative expenditures within County government. The initiative shall include a review of prior internal and external audits, consulting reports, workgroup activities, and studies. In addition, the effort should include a critical reassessment of any expenditure of contract funds for non-core services.

; and

<u>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2018 Adopted Budget includes level</u> funding for emergency shelters, \$718,399, and that it is the expectation of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors that the Interim Director and the County Executive will execute, or present to the County Board for approval, supplemental contract amendments for emergency shelter funding that equal the amount of \$718,399 provided in the 2018 Budget.
