- SUBJECT: Request for authorization to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness/Radio Services to provide for hosting services and governance of the OASIS shared radio core.

<u>REQUEST</u>

The Office of Emergency Management (OEM) is requesting authorization to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness/Radio Services (Waukesha County) for the governance, operation, and hosting of the jointly-owned OASIS Shared Core.

BACKGROUND

The provisioning of radio communications to public safety agencies is critical to their operational efficiency and safety and to the well-being of the citizens they serve. The current individual 800MHz analog trunked radio systems now in use in Waukesha County and Milwaukee County have served each County well but are aging, expensive to maintain, and do not make efficient use of the radio spectrum and technology that is now available.

Milwaukee County Res. File. No. 13-886 authorized the execution of the Contract for Service with Motorola Solutions Inc. for the implementation of the OASIS 800 MHz Public Safety Radio Sub-System connected to the Waukesha County Radio Sub-System through a jointly owned and operated Shared Radio Core.

The OASIS regional 800MHz digital trunked radio system will make more efficient use of available radio spectrum, increase interoperability, and decrease operational costs to each county, all while allowing for better coordination of radio voice communications between both Counties by allowing large numbers of users to share common technology.

The OASIS system achieves the delivery of its services through the use of a set of "core" equipment. OASIS employs a Shared Core that was procured jointly by Milwaukee County and Waukesha County to reduce each County's total cost. The

OASIS Shared Core is physically located at the Waukesha County Radio Services building and operations of the OASIS Shared Core has hosting costs associated with staffing, power, HVAC, radio tower space, equipment/server room rack space, and building depreciation.

Milwaukee County now seeks to explicitly document the terms and conditions with Waukesha County regarding the operation and costs of the OASIS Shared Core in an OASIS Shared Core MOU. As part of the MOU, Milwaukee County is agreeing to pay Waukesha County a sum of \$75,000 from OEM's 2017 operating budget for Milwaukee County's share of the OASIS Shared Core hosting costs incurred in 2016. In addition, the parties agree to pay the OASIS Shared Core hosting costs on an annual basis with an escalator of 3% per year. The term of the OASIS Share Core MOU will be for a period of ten (10) years with automatic consecutive 2-year terms thereafter

RECOMMENDATION

The Director of the Office of Emergency Management respectfully requests authorization to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Waukesha County Department of Emergency Preparedness/Radio Services (Waukesha County) for the governance, operation, and hosting of the jointly owned OASIS Shared Core.

FISCAL IMPACT

This MOU will authorize a payment of \$75,000 to Waukesha County for costs associated with operation and maintenance of the Shared Radio Core that were incurred in FY 2016, and payments in subsequent years at that amount adjusted by a 3% annual escalator. Payments to Waukesha County for the initial ten (10) year term total \$859,790.95. Payments for the 2016 and 2017 OASIS Shared Core costs will be made using funding from the Office of Emergency Management's 2017 operating budget.
