15 16 17	WHEREAS, on June 1, 2016, Pretrial Services implemented the Laura and John Arnold Foundation's Public Safety Assessment (PSA) to provide pretrial risk assessment and release recommendations to the Court; and

22 23 24	WHEREAS, JusticePoint, Inc., will contract with Luminosity, Inc., to complete a four-phase assessment of Milwaukee County's pretrial system, including stakeholder engagement sessions, and a validation study of the PSA; and
