11	A RESOLUTION

14	WHEREAS, the Milwaukee Winter Farmers Market (MWFM) is operated by the
15	Fondy Food Center, whose mission is to "connect neighborhoods to fresh, local food –
16	from farm to market to table"; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, the MWFM began in 2009 at the Wisconsin State Fair Park and
19	moved to the Mitchell Park Horticultural Conservatory's Show Dome and lobby for the
20	2013/2014 season; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, in January 2015, the market moved to the newly built Greenhouse
23	Annex next to the Mitchell Park Horticultural Conservatory, where it has remained for
24	the past three and a half years; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, at the end of the 2017-2018 winter market season the Department
27	of Parks, Recreation and Culture informed the MWFM that the event could no longer be
28	housed in the Annex; and
29 30	WHEREAS MWEM began the energy for a new location, but reports that it is
30 31	WHEREAS, MWFM began the search for a new location, but reports that it is unable to find a suitable location for the market; and
32	unable to find a suitable location for the market, and
33	WHEREAS, the MWFM is open to the public and the Annex provides a sunny
33 34	attraction for visitors during the winter months from November to April; and
35	attraction for visitors during the winter months from November to April, and
36	WHEREAS, Fondy's estimates that the MWFM generates more than \$1,000,000
37	for its 79 farmers and local food vendors each season; and

39	WHEREAS, the MWFM provides urban residents an opportunity to purchase
40	nutritional, fresh food, from local vendors, accepts people with FoodShare benefits, and
41	stimulates the economy; now, therefore,

- 42 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors supports
- 43 and requests that the Administration and the Department of Parks, Recreation and
- 44 Culture continue Milwaukee County's partnership with the Milwaukee Winter Farmers
- 45 Market by negotiating a new lease with Fondy Food Center to keep the market at the
- 46 Mitchell Park Horticultural Conservatory's Annex for consideration by the County Board.
