WHEREAS, the Disabilities Services Division (DSD), Department of Health and Human Services, administers the Birth to Three Program/Early Intervention services in Milwaukee County to infants and toddlers with developmental delays or disabilities; and

WHEREAS, in early March, DSD, received notice from Lutheran Social Services, one of its long-standing Birth to Three providers, that it was unable to continue its contract for screening and evaluation services; and

WHEREAS, to support uninterrupted service delivery during the remainder of 2018, and ensure continued compliance with State and Federal regulations, it is necessary to reallocate the balance remaining on the contract with Lutheran Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of May 17, 2018, recommended adoption of File No. 18-327 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Acting Director, Department of Health and Human Services, or her designee, to increase the existing 2018 Purchase of Service Contract with Curative Care Network, Inc., in the following amount for the period effective June 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018:
