SUBJECT: Request to Create 2.0 FTE Community Intervention Specialists in the Housing Division of the

Department of Health and Human Services

## **Background**

The Housing Division of the Department of Health and Human Services has begun to form new partnerships with local HMOs interested in adopting the Housing First model. Local HMOs will use their own funds to pay for housing for participants who continue to cycle through emergency rooms and have a long history of homelessness. The 2.0 FTE new positions of Community Intervention Specialist would primarily assist members of HMOs in the navigation of the Housing Divisions services.

## **Fiscal Effect**

The full cost of the 2.0 FTEs Community Intervention Specialist positions would be paid by the HMOs, so there is no direct tax levy impact. The Community Intervention Specialist positions will not be filled if outside funding is not obtained for these positions.

## Recommendation

Upon secured funding, the Department of Administrative Services recommends the creation of the following positions in Housing Division of the Department of Health and Human Services.
