WHEREAS Housing Division of the Department of Health and Human Services has begun to form partnerships with local Health Management Organizations (HMOs) interested in the Housing First philosophy; and

WHEREAS the HMOs are willing to pay for the cost of housing for HMO participants; and

WHEREAS the HMOs are willing to pay for all costs related to 2.0 FTEs Community Intervention Specialists within the Housing Division of the Department of Health and Human Services in order to provide navigation of housing services for their qualifying members; and

WHEREAS the Housing Division is under capacity issues and serving additional referrals from HMOs requires additional resources, including time and effort in the form of employee related capital,

WHEREAS additional staff capacity is necessary to properly assist additional people referred by HMOs and maintain current administrative operational demands and requirements; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and approves the following position action for the Department of Health and Human Services – Housing Division, effective June 14, 2018.
