- A. The Zoo Director requests authorization to execute a contract with Universal Exhibition Group to host a Brick Dino special exhibit for the 2019 season.
- B. In order to reserve this exhibit for the 2109 season, the Zoo needs to pay a deposit of \$35,000 in 2018. The 2018 Budget includes deposits for the next year's special exhibit. The total cost of the contract including shipping totals \$159,200 of which \$124,200 will be included in the 2019 Budget. The preliminary exhibit budget for 2019 will include \$238,413 in total expenditures with \$351,236 in revenues for a tax levy savings of \$112,823. An admission fee of \$3 will be charged.
- C. The 2018 Budget includes sufficient funds to cover the cost of the deposit. The Zoo cannot reserve the exhibit for 2019 without a deposit in 2018.
