8 9 10 11	WHEREAS, in 2002, Milwaukee County's (the County) Public Art Committee agreed to erect a piece of art at Gordon Park; and
12 13 14	WHEREAS, artist David Middlebrook's proposal titled "Tip" was selected by the panel; and
15 16 17	WHEREAS, "Tip" is made up of two separate sculptures, which together constitute a single art installation; and
18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, 16 years later, the basalt pillar portion of the sculpture now has structural flaws that have been deemed unsafe by the County's Facilities Condition Assessment team, as well as by Architecture and Engineering staff; and
22 23 24	WHEREAS, that portion of the sculpture currently sits in an unsafe condition, and is fenced off to keep the public safe from the potential danger should it fall; and
25 26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture plans to remove the sculpture in its entirety, including the iceberg and anvil portion, as they could pose a failure danger in future, and because the two sculptures were erected as one piece of art; and
30 31 32	WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of July 17, 2018, recommended adoption of File No. 18-494 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,
33 34 35 36	BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture to remove the entirety of the sculpture in Gordon Park, due to its unsafe condition.
