SUBJECT: Claim and Litigation Settlement Informational Report

Pursuant to the Office of Corporation Counsel's June 7, 2018 Legal Opinion (see file No. 18-25), the County has delegated settlement authority to WCMIC through its insurance contract. However, to ensure that the Board is fully aware of all such settlements, the OCC now reports all WCMIC-controlled litigation settlements and WCMIC-controlled claim resolutions. In addition, when applicable, this report will include resolutions of legal disputes covered under other County insurance policies. Also in this report, Supervisors will find a listing of the resolutions of legal claims where the County was a plaintiff, which do not require County Board approval under applicable statutes, as well as legal claims that require the County Board's approval (with the corresponding file number) of any resolution.
