The Combined Court Related Operations is requesting County Board approval to enter into a contract with Legal Aid Society, a non-profit organization, in the amount of \$2,275,296 for the 2019 fiscal year. This dollar amount has been proposed as a part of the 2019 Requested Budget. It has been negotiated that for the 2020 fiscal year, the contract amount will be \$2,472,802 in 2020. There is an option for a one year extension written into the contract for \$2,521,258 in 2021. This contract allows attorneys from LAS to represent the best interest of children in Family and Children's Court cases, as appointed by the Courts. The department anticipates no additional fiscal impact as the contract amount was requested during the 2019 budget process.
