1 2 3 4 (ITEM *) From the Director of the Risk Management Division of the Department of 5 Administrative Services, requesting a reauthorization resolution to comply with the 6 requirement of the State of Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development regarding 7 Milwaukee County self-insured workers' compensation program currently in effect, by 8 recommending adoption of the following: 9 10 **A RESOLUTION** 11 12 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County is a qualified subdivision of the State of 13 Wisconsin; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act 102.28(2)(b) provides that 16 employers covered by the Act ether insure their liability with workers' compensation 17 insurance carriers authorized to do business in Wisconsin or be exempted (self-insured) 18 from insuring liabilities with a carrier and thereby assume the responsibility for its own 19 workers' compensation risk and payment; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the State and its political subdivisions may self-insure workers' 22 compensation benefits without a special order from the Department of Workforce 23 Development Workers' Compensation Division if they agree to report faithfully all 24 compensable injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department; 25 and 26 27 WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors at its December 23, 2015 meeting approved the continuation of the self-insured workers' compensation program, in 28 29

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compliance with Wisconsin Administrative Code DWD 80.60(3); now, therefore,

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BE IT RESOLVED, that Milwaukee County shall continue its self-insured workers' compensation program that is currently in effect; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the Risk Management Division of the Department of Administrative Services or assigned designee forward certified copies of this resolution to the Worker's Compensation Division, Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.
