SUBJECT: **Request for authorization for the Chief Judge to extend the Safety and Justice Challenge Project Manager contract through December 31, 2020 – Action Item**

BACKGROUND

On April 13, 2016 Milwaukee County received from the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation a funding award notice for the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase II Implementation grant in the amount of \$2,000,000. The award period was from May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2018. A no cost extension was granted through December 31, 2019. The SJC Project Manager's contract was extended through February 28, 2019.


On October 3, 2018 Milwaukee County submitted a Phase III Implementation and Community Engagement grant. The Phase III application included funding for the Safety and Justice Challenge Manager for 22 months, through December 31, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$172,620. The SJC Project Manager provides oversight, management, and fidelity to the grant.

RECOMMENDATION

The Chief Judge recommends that the contract extension for the MacArthur Safety and Justice Challenge Project Manager be authorized.
