EXPLANATION												
This transfer increases the expenditure authority for the Menomonee River Parkway project in order to process final change orders on the project resulting from storm sewer connections and extensions due to roadway flooding risk. While green infrastructure was combined with standard storm sewer improvements in order to manage storm water along the parkway, during intense rain events and periods of frozen conditions, it was found that the green infrastructure elements like rain gardens, bioswales, and biofilitration basins did not keep up with the rate of water requiring management. As a result, County staff designed overflow solutions that connected the green infrastructure to the tensor pipe, so that the parkway road would not flood. The cost of the corrections includes vegetated matting that provides the native, deep-rooted plants that promote infiltration. This transfer will also increase the expenditure authority within the Lyons Bridge Replacement project in order to ensure timely construction and a budget that reflects updated cost estimates. Current bidding conditions have resulted in higher costs due to steel and concrete costs, the need for cold weather construction in order to minimize the risk of oak wilt to the historic trees on site, and costs for electrical work by the City of Milwaukee. It is requested that this fund transfer be approved. This transfer has no tax levy impact. Gregory G.
