


Flood Risk KK River: 6th Street – Jackson Park






KK River Project Sequence


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JACKSON PARK LAGOON IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed work would dredge the lagoon sediments and lower the water surface of the lagoon.






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
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




JACKSON PARK North of KK River Parkway


The work would also lower the backfields north of the parkway and daylight the river.













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
Flood Storage Analysis














23-Point Policy Compliance

- Demonstrating the project is a public benefit
 - Reduce flood risk
 - Reduce risk of drowning
 - Improve water quality and habitat
- Evaluate alternatives that do not include the use of parkland
- No additional cost to Milwaukee County
 - Refined park planning scope
- District/County Parks will continue to evaluate of compliance throughout project



Next Steps

- 2019: Acquire adjacent parcels
 - Field investigations (e.g. soil & sediment testing)
 - Develop Jackson Park alternatives
 - More public outreach
- 2019-20: Finalize park plan and develop agreement with Milwaukee County
- 2020: Develop final design
- 2021-23: Construct improvements
