(SUGGESTED SCRIPT FOR PUBLIC HEARING)

This public hearing is being held pursuant to the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Notice of this public hearing was published in the <u>Milwaukee Journal-Sentinel</u> and in <u>The Daily Reporter</u>, and reference is made to said published notice and the details contained therein.

The purpose of the public hearing is to give all interested persons an opportunity to express their views on the proposed issuance of \$74,230,000 general obligation bonds or notes by Milwaukee County, a portion of which will be used to finance the following projects and the location and nature of the projects to be financed:

- (i) Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,337,100 to finance building renovations and other improvements at the Milwaukee County War Memorial Center (the "War Memorial"). The War Memorial is located at 750 North Lincoln Memorial Drive, Milwaukee, Wisconsin and is used by Milwaukee County War Memorial, Inc. and Milwaukee Art Museum, Inc.;
- (ii) Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$891,600 to finance building renovations and other improvements to facilities at the Milwaukee Public Museum (the "Museum"). The Museum is located at 800 West Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin and is used by Milwaukee Public Museum, Inc.;
- (iii) Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$294,100 to finance building renovations and other improvements to the facilities at the Wilson Park Senior Center (the "Wilson Senior Center"). The Wilson Senior Center is located at 2601 W. Howard Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin and is used by Serving Older Adults of Southeast Wisconsin, Inc.;
- (iv) Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$422,000 to finance building renovations and other improvements to the facilities at the Washington Park Senior Center (the "Washington Senior Center"). The Washington Senior Center is located at 4220 W. Vilet Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin and is used by Serving Older Adults of Southeast Wisconsin, Inc.
