21 22	WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services administers the Milwaukee County's (the County) CDBG dollars and advises the Milwaukee County

36 37	WHEREAS, for 2019, HUD allocated more than \$1.6 million in CDBG dollars to the County, and the County received more than \$250,000 in requests from
37 38	municipalities for basic municipal public works, such as construction or maintenance of
39	curbs or sidewalks, and renovating public buildings contained in Adopted
40	File No. 18-856; and

42	WHEREAS, the allocation of moneys to basic public works projects, while
43 44	permissible, violates the spirit of the CDBG program, as established by Congress; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Economic and Community Development, at its
meeting of March 11, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-153 (vote 5-0); now,
therefore,

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BE IT RESOLVED, Milwaukee County (the County) establishes the policy of
prioritizing the award of its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding
allocation to municipalities and non-profit organizations whose projects shall work
toward improving the general welfare and economic status of low and moderate-income
persons in the County; and

55 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in its scoring system, the County shall reduce the 56 priority of awarding CDBG dollars to municipalities or non-profits for basic public works 57 or administrative functions including but not limited to:

- Construction or reconstruction of curbs, gutters, sidewalks, or roads

- Construction or renovation of buildings, which do not expressly serve the purpose of improving the general welfare or economic opportunities for

65 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County expects municipalities and local 66 non-profit organizations awarded CDBG dollars through the County demonstrate 67 objectively how the grant improves housing, the general welfare, or economic opportunities of County citizens of low and moderate incomes, as determined by the 68 69 United States Department of Housing and Urban Development so the County can 70 prioritize applications over those that do not offer improvement in those areas; and 71 72 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County requests that the Department of 73 Health and Human Services modify its CDBG policies and project scoring criteria to

- 74 effectively implement this policy and communicate it to potential applicants.
