3 A resolution by Supervisor Haas, recognizing May 11, 2019, as World Migratory Bird
4 Day in Milwaukee County, by recommending adoption of the following:

6 **A RESOLUTION**
7

8 WHEREAS, migratory birds are some of the most beautiful and easily observed
9 wildlife in our community; and
10

11 WHEREAS, many citizens recognize and welcome migratory songbirds as
12 symbolic harbingers of spring; and
13

14 WHEREAS, these migrant species play an important economic role in our
15 community and assist in controlling insects and pests; and
16

17 WHEREAS, migratory birds and their habitats are declining throughout the
18 Americas, facing a growing number of threats on their migration routes and in both their
19 summer and winter homes; and
20

21 WHEREAS, public awareness and concern are crucial components of migratory
22 bird conservation; and
23

24 WHEREAS, citizens enthusiastic about birds, informed about the threats they
25 face, and empowered to help address those threats, can directly contribute to
26 maintaining healthy bird populations; and
27

28 WHEREAS, since 1993, World Migratory Bird Day (WMBD) has become a
29 primary vehicle for focusing public attention on the nearly 350 species that travel
30 between nesting habitats in our communities and throughout North America, and their
31 wintering grounds in South and Central America, Mexico, the Caribbean, and the
32 Southern United States; and

34 WHEREAS, hundreds of thousands of people will observe WMBD, gathering in
35 town squares, community centers, schools, parks, nature centers, and wildlife refuges
36 to celebrate, learn about birds, and take conservation action; and
37

38 WHEREAS, while WMBD is officially held each year on the second Saturday of
39 May, its observance is not limited to a single day, and planners are encouraged to
40 schedule activities on the dates best suited to the presence of both migrants and
41 celebrants; and
42

43 WHEREAS, WMBD is not only a day to foster appreciation for wild birds and to
44 celebrate and support migratory bird conservation, but is also a call to action; and
45

46 WHEREAS, on February 1, 2018, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors
47 adopted File No. 18-105, recognizing May 12, 2018, as International Migratory Bird
48 Day; and

50 WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of
51 March 12, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-274 (vote 4-0); now, therefore,

53 BE IT RESOLVED, Milwaukee County hereby proclaims May 11, 2019, as World
54 Migratory Bird Day, and urges all residents to celebrate this observance, and to support
55 efforts to protect and conserve migratory birds and their habitats within the community.
