



Plan for Spring/Summer 2019

Increase enforcement by increasing the Park Ranger patrols & compliance checks at peak hours.

Place signage reminding folks to pay their fees along with potential penalties/fines.

Experiment with a multi-use facility, which would include Disc Golf at Madison Park.

Continue to improve current amenities at the courses including pads, baskets and tee signs.
