From the Superintendent, House of Correction (HOC), requesting authorization to execute a contract extension to an existing Purchase of Service Agreement with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for inmate food services at the HOC and Criminal Justice Facility, and \$200,000 in capital expenditures for the period effective January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2021, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the current food services contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC (Aramark), expires on December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals was issued on August 11, 2014, and Aramark was selected as the provider; and

WHEREAS, on November 11, 2014, File No. 14-794 was adopted, which granted the House of Correction (HOC) the authority to enter into a contract with Aramark for food service provision at the both the HOC and Criminal Justice Facility (CJF); and

WHEREAS, the terms of the contract approved by Adopted File No. 14-794 began January 1, 2015, through December 31, 2017, with two additional, one-year extensions subject to the approval of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Aramark has agreed to a new contract extension with the same provisions, and a significant capital infusion of \$200,000, and Milwaukee County will own the equipment at the end of the two year extension; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of April 18, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-364 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Superintendent, House of Correction, enter into a new two-year contract extension with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, to provide inmate food services, and \$200,000 in capital expenditures through December 31, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the aforementioned contract extension will only be executed after review and approval by Community Business Development Partners, Department of Administrative Services, Corporation Counsel, and Risk Management.
