  - A. Authorization to enter into a lease with Bartolotta Restaurant Group, LLC (Bartolotta), for the management and operation of food and beverage services at McKinley Roundhouse and surrounding environs. The lease is for three (3) years with two (2) options to extend for three (3) consecutive years.
  - B. The vendor has agreed to pay the County a commission of four percent (4%) on gross sales as defined in the contract for the initial term and each renewal. Additionally, Bartolotta will establish a Park Improvement Fund of one percent (1%) of gross sales, for the purpose of maintaining and enhancing the McKinley Roundhouse, parking lot, and/or other environs having a positive impact on McKinley Roundhouse. Bartolotta will also reimburse a share of certain utilities.
  - C. Revenue of \$8,500 is accounted for in the 2019 budget. Based on the projections of Bartolotta Restaurant Group, LLC., it is estimated that Parks will receive an additional \$5,500 of revenue in 2019 and an additional \$9,500 in 2020.
  - D. It is assumed that Bartolotta's revenues will be \$350,000 in the first year and \$450,000 in the second year based on the RFP response.
