SUBJECT: Re-appointment of Bettie A. Rodgers to the Commission on Aging

Subject to the confirmation of your Honorable Body and pursuant to the provisions set forth in Milwaukee County General Ordinances Chapter 53.03 I am hereby re-appointing Bettie A. Rodgers to the Milwaukee County Commission on Aging. Ordinance indicates that the sixteen-member Commission shall reflect representation of at least eight senior citizens over the age of sixty; at least four members shall reside in Milwaukee County suburbs; at least four members shall reside in the City of Milwaukee; at least one member shall be a County Board Supervisor; and one member shall represent the health community. Ms. Rodgers is more than sixty years of age and resides in the City of Milwaukee, and maintains an active interest in issues facing older adults in our community.

Ms. Rodgers term will end on April 4, 2022.
