RE: Request to Amend Section 17.14(21) of the Milwaukee County Code of General

Ordinances Related to Provide Clarification that Call-In Pay Shall be Paid at the Overtime

Rate

At its April 25, 2019, meeting, the County Board of Supervisors approved File 19-391 which provided clarification on and standardized various pay adjustments for all employees except those represented by public safety unions.

The intent in File 19-391 was to provide the same level of benefits at a minimum to employees. Although the fiscal note accurately reflected that the recommendation was to pay call-in pay at the overtime rate for the work session, the ordinance change incorrectly reflected that it be paid at straight time.

Approval of this request will amend Section 17.14(21) of the Milwaukee County General Ordinances to accurately reflect the intent of File 19-391.
